

King David Visitor Policy

In keeping with our Communicable Disease Prevention Plan (CDPP), King David has put measures in place to ensure we are providing a safe and healthy environment for our staff and students. With the advent of a vaccine for COVID-19 and rising vaccination rate in BC, in combination with our CDPP, we are going to return gradually to allowing visitors to come into the school.

It is crucial for the school to slowly implement this change to ensure it is manageable, safe and, adheres to local and provincial public health orders and guidelines. To begin, visitors to the school will be limited to individuals:

- Who are making essential and meaningful contributions to the school's programming
- Who have appointments with staff in the administrative area of the school
- Who have an appointment for a reason approved by the school (ie. school tour, maintenance, etc.)

All visitors to the school must comply with the following:

- Show proof of vaccination (both shots) using BC's mobile vaccine passport
- Wear a mask at all times (this applies to all visitors aged 5 and up)**
- Complete our visitor form which includes providing contact information

As conditions change in the province or region, this policy will be updated to ensure the school continues to meet all public health guidelines and orders.

***There are mask-wearing exemptions for:*

- *People with health conditions or with physical, cognitive or mental impairments who cannot wear one*
- *People who cannot remove a mask on their own*
- *Children under the age of 5*
- *People who need to remove their masks to communicate due to another person's hearing impairment*
